Abstract: Abstract should be the same as the 35-word abstract which will be submitted with this manuscript. Scientific or engineering symbols or acronyms should not be included inside the abstract. Font size should be 9 pts.

Keywords: Spot light, Street lamp, Light source, OLED, LED

1. Introduction

A template is a set of styles and page layout settings that determine the appearance of a document. This template matches the printer settings that will be used to the proceeding. In order to provide a consistent appearance of the manuscripts, it is important for the authors to use this template.

2. Title section

Paper size should be 21 cm x 29.7 cm A4 size. Margins should be set for a 2.6-cm top, a 2.2-cm bottom, and a 2.2-cm left and right. The page length should be 3 pages. Over-length manuscripts are not accepted. The font should be Times New Roman.

2.1 Title, authors' names, and author affiliation

Center the title. The first letters of every word are capitalized. The title should be in 14 pts., bold font. Center author names using 9 pts. Authors' names should appear as used for conventional publication, with first and middle names or initials followed by surname. Center author affiliations using 9 pts. Affiliations should follow the format: division, organization, country.

2.2 Abstract

The abstract section should be started with the word "Abstract" in bold, followed by a colon. Font size should be 9 pts. The abstract should be an explicit summary of the paper. The abstract should be the same as the 35-word abstract which will be submitted with this manuscript.

2.3 Keyword

List 5-10 keywords or short phrases that well represent the content of the manuscript. Except proper nouns and acronyms, keywords should be typed in lower case letters. Font size should be 9 pts.

3. Main text

The main text should be set in two-column format with a minimum 8-mm gutter between columns. Font size should be 10 pts. The first line of the first paragraph of a section or subsection should be left aligned.

The first line of subsequent paragraphs within the section or subsection should be indented 0.62 cm.

3.1 References

At the point of bibliographic citation, designate the reference by using superscript number in after last corresponding word followed by the right parenthesis ¹⁾.

4. Figures, photos, tables, and equations

Figures, photos, tables, and equations should be in black-and-white. Captions should be placed under the figures and the photos, and above the tables. Font size for the caption should be 10 pts.

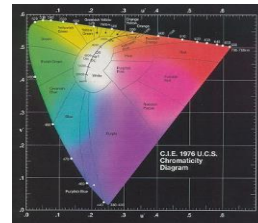


Fig. 1 Sample figure.
